The successful candidate may be involved in engineering activities such as topographical surveys, construction layout, site inspections, producing AutoCad drawings, reports, and perform other office or field related duties as assigned.

Preferred candidates will have the ability to perform basic calculations from field note data and read, interpret, and use topographic maps and design drawings; understand basic survey and CAD computer applications; follow established safety procedures and safely utilize equipment to perform specified job duties; communicate clearly and work well with others; and keep work sites and equipment clean and in an orderly fashion.

Deployment to other duties may be required from time to time.

Required Skills, Qualifications and Abilities:

- Registered as a full-time, post-secondary student in the field of civil engineering at an accredited institution during the current academic year (2020-2021) and returning to school full-time in the upcoming academic year (2021-2022). Proof of enrolment will be required and can be included as part of your application package.

- 4. Independence of judgment and capability of working with minimal supervision.
