The successful candidate will be required to perform refuse collection in a safe and efficient manner, operating various types and sizes of one-person refuse packers; refuse will be collected in a prescribed manner along assigned routes. Deployment to other duties may be required from time to time. Hours of work may include weekends and shifts.

Required Skills, Qualifications and Abilities:

- 1. Completion of Grade 12.
- 2. Possession and maintenance of a valid Class 3 B.C. Driver's Licence with air endorsement; a satisfactory current driver's abstract will be required.
- 3. One (1) year of experience driving tandem axle trucks and demonstrable ability and aptitude to operate various types of right-hand drive refuse packers in multiple stop and start conditions.
- 4. Operation of sanders/plows.
- 5. Demonstrable interpersonal and public relations skills.
- 6. Demonstrable ability to lift and carry refuse containers.
- 7. Demonstrable ability to work either alone, or as a member of a team, in a repetitive environment under minimal supervision.
- 8. Demonstrable ability to follow legal pre-trip and post-trip inspections, maintain written records, and follow prescribed routes.
- 9. The position may be physically demanding; candidate must be able to successfully perform all duties associated with the position. A medical certificate attesting to suitability for this position may be required.
